Dear Mr. Rück:

The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) has reviewed your request accepted May 14, 2018. This request was for approval of the Dräger X-plore halfmask models 3300 (part numbers R55330, R55331 and R55332), 3500 (part numbers R55350, R55351 and R55352), 3350 (part numbers AH10263, AH10264 and AH10265) and 3550 (part numbers AH10260, AH10261 and AH10262) and alternate bayonet-style particulate filter (part number 6740830) for protections against particulates at a P100 filter efficiency level.

In addition, the filter cartridge user instructions (part number 9021497) is obsoleted and replaced by the user instructions, part number 9100034. The two complete configurations for which approval is requested along with the configurations subject to extension of approval are detailed on assembly matrix, file name *DRA240a_HMask_AMa.xlsx*, dated May 3, 2018.

This request is granted. Approvals and extension of approvals are granted only for documentation written in the English language. It is the manufacturer's responsibility to correctly translate materials desired to be produced in languages other than English. New approval numbers have been assigned as shown in the table below:

The final respirator and filter approval labels are included as attachments to this letter. The cautions and limitations which apply to these approvals are on the approval labels. Only those assemblies affected by this request, or where new approval numbers are assigned, apply to this approval action. Production approval labels cannot include information on unapproved configurations.

The approved assemblies consist of the parts as listed on the approval labels and the assembly matrix. Parts are to be marked and the numbers indicated on the approval label in a legible and permanent manner (marking cannot be removed without evidence of its previous presence).

This certificate of approval is not an endorsement of the respirators by NIOSH, and such endorsement shall not be stated or implied in advertisements or other publicity. However, you may publicize the fact that these respirators have met the requirements of Title 42, *Code of Federal Regulations*, Part 84 (42 CFR 84).

No changes may be made to any respirators and accompanying documentation without prior written approval of NIOSH. Requests for changes must be submitted to NIOSH and a modification of this approval must be granted before changes are made.
